Developing Guidelines and Standards for Design of Campus Facilities

The Higher Education Commission (HEC) Pakistan is establishing new universities and sub campuses in almost every district headquarter of the country in consultation and collaboration with the provincial governments to improve equitable access to higher education across the Country. This will require development and expansion of infrastructure and academic facilities. HEC considers that the purpose of a university is to bring together diverse people and their ideas in an environment that creates potential for intellectual and social exchange. A university plan must have the potential to knit together the diverse elements of the campus in a coherent way.

HEC Islamabad intends to develop guidelines and standards for design of campus facilities. The building code and zoning ordinance should establish minimum regulations to cover aspects of the construction, alteration, addition, repairing, changing of occupancy, demolition, of every building structure and any appurtenances attached to the building structure. For this purpose, HEC is seeking the services of consultants with requisite qualification and experience to carry out this task. Interested consultants may obtain TORs from the office of undersigned on payment of Rs. 500/- on or before January 20, 2017 during working hours. **Single-stage two envelope procedure** will be followed.

Last date for submission of bids (Technical and Financial) is **January 24, 2017 at 1400 hours** and the technical bids will be opened on the same day at 1430 hours in the Lecture Hall, HEC, Sector H-9, Islamabad.
