

A Ceremony for signing Document of Understanding between HEC and CRBC China Organized at HEC, Islamabad

An official ceremony for signing the “Document of Understanding (DOU)” between Higher Education Commission (HEC), Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and China Road and Bridge Corporation (CRBC), a state-owned company of the People's Republic of China, was organized at HEC, Islamabad on 2nd October 2017.



It was mutually agreed with consensus that the CRBC China would sponsor 30 Pakistani students for Master’s degree program in Transportation Engineering at Southeast University China consecutively for two academic years. The scholarship will be fully funded and cover the tuition, accommodation, return airfare and living stipend for all awardees.



Since this scholarship program is in line with Government of Pakistan’s vision of development through China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) that works on a well-defined pathway for regional connectivity enhancing people-to-people contact through academic, economic and cultural relations. The program is destined to open new vistas of opportunities for prospective Pakistani youth enabling them to acquire state-of-the-art knowledge from reputed Chinese institutes of higher learning in the field of Engineering.



The first batch of 14 students selected through a rigorous and competitive selection process by HEC, CRBC and South East University, China will proceed to China by the mid of October 2017 to pursue Masters in Transportation Engineering starting from fall 2017 semester.
